Grounds Maintenance Update

We are still closely monitoring the grounds maintenance contractor, to ensure they are carrying out the service to an acceptable standard.

Gould's have advised that they are increasing staff levels and that bush and hedge maintenance will be picked up as a priority. Our internal estates team will continue to support where possible.

Our Estates Manager has already completed a site walk around with Tameside Council and Goulds, with attempts to marry up the planned works dates. Additionally, a site meeting has been arranged with Goulds' CEO to discuss progress and concerns.

Meal deals not to be missed!

Asda - Keep hunger at bay during your weekly shop at ASDA, as children aged 16 and under can eat for £1 when dining at any time of day in Asda Cafés.

Bella Italia - kids can get three courses and a drink for just £1 with every purchase of an adult meal.

Dunelm - Pausa Cafe is offering a free kids menu for every £4 spent in their in-store cafes. Available all day, everyday.

Ikea - you can get the kids pasta or mac and cheese for just 95p from 11am. Other kids meals are also available for the higher price of £1.50.
