In the event of a fire, a fire door will help to stop the fire and smoke spreading by containing it.

Fire doors automatically close back on themselves once they are open. This is an important safety feature to ensure they provide the protection needed if a fire broke out.

Fire doors won't work and you are at risk when:

- The closers are removed
- The doors are damaged
- The doors are altered by adding things like door bells, door signage, chains or cat flaps

To keep yourself and everyone in your building safe:

- Please keep fire doors shut and never prop or wedge them open
- Please report any damage or repairs to us
